Discussion and Other Business:

Committee decided to waive enforcement or allow a grace period until the November meeting for answering course level justification questions. This will also provide enough time for college/program guidelines to be posted. Courses that were submitted before the summer (or before the questions were added to the form) should be updated as there has been notification and enough time to make the changes and the question is very easy to complete.

Update course form to remove the text box after selecting college/program policy. Appears to be redundant if colleges are to submit their standards. Since courses are approved by the college before they get to UCC, they are certifying the course is meeting their own standards.

J.Herman asked if any of the colleges had found any non-traditional courses that did not meet the traditional equivalencies. He stated their college had one that did not meet the equivalencies, however, they informed the department they could revise and resubmit for approval.

Clarification on when college/program standards were due. Be sure to send for November UCC meeting. They will be posted on the UCC website for future reference.

Galveston non-traditional courses memo was not on consent agenda; send now so that it can be voted on via e-vote.

S.Graves brought up Senate Bill 810 which was recently approved by the legislature regarding open access educational resources. Current discussions with Provost Office, Registrar and EIS to add this to Howdy. This will be done through the section level (not course level through CARS).

J.Jasperson sent an email inquiry about how UCC would be addressing college guidelines. J.Herman will send to committee for discussion in November.

Anticipate November agenda will be large so try to resolve issues before the meeting.
