The committee discussed the following under Other Business.

# 1. Fall 2021 COVID Syllabus Statement

The committee is in agreement with the same approach that was taken last year. For new course requests coming through between now and the end of the semester, the committee will not require the Fall 2021 statement to be on the syllabus.

Concerns were expressed about former Spring 2021 COVID statement old language could be taken out of context and lead someone to believe that Texas A&M is making students wear masks. Committee decided it would probably be best to remove Spring 2021 COVID language to protect everyone, but if the Fall 2021 statement is utilized, then that will be fine.

## 2. Reminder about Syllabi

A newly proposed course being put forward for both traditional and non-traditional simultaneously, the committee agreed last year that only a single syllabus would be required, rather than multiple (i.e. traditional and non-traditional). If a course is already approved for traditional and is being proposed for non-traditional, then the committee will continue to expect the attached syllabus to reflect the non-traditional information.

# 3. Non-Traditional Approvals for Spring 2022

The UCC will continue considering courses through the Fall semester that are being proposed to offer non-traditionally.

Typically, once a course is submitted in CARS for non-traditional format and is approved by UCC, the course will be updated in the system by Curricular Services, however, in March of 2021 the Provost Office placed a moratorium in respect to the 2021-2022 academic year. No course can be scheduled for non-traditional online delivery, unless the course either had been offered Fall 2019 non-traditionally online or had received non-traditional approval prior to March 31, 2021. A course that the committee might consider this semester can still be approved by the committee to be offered non-traditionally, however, the unit would not be able to schedule it non-traditionally online without permission from the provost office or a revision of the statement from the provost office. Dr. 'Jon Jasperson reached out to Dr. Tim Scott who is working on getting further clarification, but as of right now, scheduling non-traditionally online for Spring 2022 is still under the moratorium.

As a reminder, non-traditional format approval is not only for requesting a course to be taught online, but it is also for requesting a course to be taught in a different part of term. Shortened part of terms requests are able to be approved and scheduled, it is the online format approval that are subject to the moratorium and are not being scheduled at this time.

## 4. Deadlines for Degrees and Courses

New Degree programs (bachelor's and master's) deadline is the November UCC meeting. Courses and general curriculum changes deadline is the December UCC meeting.
