The committee met via Zoom to discuss the following under Other Business. The curricular items were approved via e-vote.

## 1. SACSCOC New Substative Change Policy - Dr. Michael T. Stephenson

Dr. Michael Stephenson, Vice Provost for Academic Affairs and Strategic Initiatives was present to provide information regarding the new SACSCOC Substative Change Policy that went into effect on January 1, 2021. Dr. Stephenson presented key points that are most likely to affect those here at Texas A&M University. Handouts of the presentation were provided within the UCC March Agenda.

For new Programs with 50% or more new content requiring SACSCOC approval prior to implementation, the UCC discussed the deadline for new programs and all new courses required for the new programs to be submitted and received by UCC by the November agenda deadline. It was discussed that the deadline and information posted on the Registrar website "Deadline for Curricular Approvals - November Deadline" be updated to include specific program information (degrees, certificates) and all new courses required for those new programs. These updates have been made to the Registrar Website at https://registrar.tamu.edu/Our-Services/Curricular-Services/Curricular-Processes#0-DeadlineforCurricularApprovals.

## 2. Course Description Format

The possibility for revising the course description format was discussed. This discussion was brought forth to the committee to provide an opportunity to allow for a different set of guidelines since the catalog is no longer printed. Several colleges expressed the same conserns of not being interested in going back and revising all previous course descriptions. There was discussion about the possibly of revising going forward, however, there was not much enthusiasm. Based upon the discussions, no action is being taken. This was only a topic for committee discussion.

3. Topic brought to committee for discussion: Online Catalog (Current and Preliminary Catalogs)

Dr. Dormire from the College of Nursing presented the idea of having two online catalogs (current and preliminary catalogs) available online like Florida Atlantic University (FAU) uses with a July curricular deadline:

https://www.fau.edu/registrar/registration/catalog.php# and the possiblity of an improvement to processes. These catalogs were reviewed and the topic was discussed by the committee. The deadline for Texas A&M catalogs were shared in detail for the reasons why the deadlines are set the way they are currently. Concerns were expressed for having a preliminary catalog that a student would come in with expectations of something being approved, as well as keeping up with changes in two posted catalogs. Based upon discussion and the reason why Texas A&M has the current deadlines and processes, then it was decided that having two online catalogs would not necessarily align with Texas A&M's processes and improve the current curricular and catalog processes.
