SUBJECT: Assignment of Undergraduate Course Levels

The School of Military Science is composed of four departments: Aerospace Studies, Military Science, Naval Science, and School of Military Science. None of the four departments offers degree programs.

The departments of Aerospace Studies, Military Science, and Naval Science offer ROTC courses. These courses are prescribed by the affiliated branch of the military. The U.S. Air Force determines course content and course levels for Air Force ROTC program; the U.S. Army determines course content and course levels for the Army ROTC program; and the U.S. Navy determine course content and course levels for the Naval ROTC program.

Explanation of course level assignment is included in the Texas A&M Undergraduate Catalog under each ROTC program.

The School of Military Science also offers ten courses to support their Certificate in Leadership Study and Development. The following process is used to determine course levels.

1. The Administrative Officer of the School of Military Science reviews course levels for all new course proposals.
2. The instructor presents the syllabus and, if applicable, explains the program associated with the course.
3. The Administrative Officer of the School of Military Science uses standards developed by the Center for Teaching Excellence to determine course level.
